1 Viura, Campo Nuevo £3.20 £6.30 £17.95
 – Navarra, Spain V (Abv 12%)
 Aromas of green apple, pear and citrus that lead to a dry, fresh and light palate.

2 Pinot Grigio, Ca Tesore £3.70 £7.30 £20.95
 – Veneto, Italy (Abv 12%)
 Fresh and crisp dry wine with notes of almonds and a light refreshing finish.

3 Sauvignon Blanc, Tonada £3.90 £7.70 £21.95
 – Central Valley, Chile (Abv 12.5%)
 Tropical fruit aromas, clean palate and fabulous zesty feel at the end.

4 Fernao Pires, Terra de Lobos £22.95
 – Ribatejo, Portugal
 Perfumed, light and delicious with notes of apricot, steel and crisp lime acidity.

5 Marsanne/Viognier, Xavier Roger £23.95
 – France
 From two classic Rhone grape varieties; light floral nose with soft and peachy flavours on the palate.

6 Fiano, Carlomagno £24.95
 – Puglia, Italy
 A beautiful wine from this lesser known grape variety. Fruity on the nose, with exotic fruit such as melon and banana, featuring hints of citrus reminiscent of grapefruit

7 Sauvignon Blanc, Kuraka £27.95
 – Marlborough, New Zealand
 Passion fruit & gooseberry on the nose with wild limes coming through in this amazing finish

8 Albarino, Alba Vega £28.95
 – Galicia, Spain
 From Rias Baixas in the North; Spain's answer to Sancerre, crisp, refreshing with aromatic peachy flavours.

9 Bacchus, Sharpham Dart Valley Reserve £33.95
 – Devon, England
 Fruit aromas with hints of vanilla, ripe fruit with balanced acidity, a touch of residual sugar and a hint of oak.

10 Sancerre, "Le Perrier" £38.95
 Domain Jean Thomas – Loire, France
 Bouquet of fresh cut grass on the nose, minerality on the palate and subtle gooseberry coming through.
