11 Tempranillo, Campo Nuevo (Abv 13.5%)
 – Navarra, Spain £3.35 £6.65 £18.95
 Aromas of cassis and mulberry with a palate which is soft and well rounded and is smooth on the finish.

12 Pinot Noir, Lautarul £3.85 £7.65 £21.95
 – Romania (Abv 12%)
 A light and soft Pinot Noir with traces of herbs on the nose with red cherry fruit reflected on the palate.

13 Merlot, Tonada £3.95 £7.90 £22.95
 – Central Valley, Chile (Abv 13%)
 Hints of smokey plum and damson on the nose followed by notes of tobacco and spice coming through in the finish.

14 Cinsaut Pinotage, Waterval £23.95
 – Boschendal, South Africa
 A beautiful blend, bursting with ripe plum and dark berry fruit flavours.

15 AB+ Alicante–Bouschet, Xavier Roger
 – Languedoc–Roussillon, France £24.95
 Complexity of berry and cherries with darker black fruits on the finish creating a wine with elegance and power.

16 Primitivo Appassimento, £26.95
 – Carlomagno, Puglia, Italy
 A full bodied, rich and powerful wine. Intense red colour with aromas and flavours of cherries, raspberries, plum spices and chocolate.

17 Cabernet Franc ‘Les Argelières’ £27.95
 – Languedoc, France
 Dark purplely red in the glass, blackcurrant and green pepper aromas, typical of the Cabernet Franc grape variety. Smooth, fruity, medium bodied on the palate, spicy finish.

18 Syrah ‘Smart Dog’ JP Ramos £28.95
 – Alentejo, Portugal
 Deep ruby colour, rich nose of creamed black fruits, sweet spice and touches of liquorice and pepper.

19 Malbec Reserve, Gougenheim £30.95
 – Mendoza, Argentina
 Aged briefly in 50–50 new and 3 year old barrels. Warming with deep fruit flavours with a rich and complex palate.

20 Chat. Semonlon, Haut Medoc Cru Bourgeois
 Bordeaux, France £37.95
 Unoaked style with lovely soft Merlot fruit, integrated ripe tannins in balance with beautiful berry fruit flavours in the palate.
