1 Viura, Campo Nuevo	£3.35	£6.65	£18.95
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– Navarra, Spain (Abv 12%)
Aromas of green apple, pear and citrus that lead to a dry, fresh and light palate.

2 Pinot Grigio, Ca' Tesore	£3.85	£7.65	£21.95
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– Veneto, Italy (Abv 12%)
The nose has hints of lemon balm, green apple and pear and the palate is dry and zesty with vibrant floral notes.

3 Sauvignon Blanc, Tonada	£3.95	£7.90	£22.95
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– Central Valley, Chile (Abv 12.5%)
Tropical fruit aromas, clean palate fabulous zesty feel at the end.

4 Fernao Pires, Terra de Lobos			£23.95
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– Ribatejo, Portugal
Perfumed, light and delicious with notes of apricot, steel and crisp lime acidity.

5 Marsanne/Viognier, Xavier Roger			£24.95
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– France
From two classic Rhone grape varieties; light floral nose with soft and peachy flavours on the palate.

6 Fiano, Carlomagno			£26.95
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– Puglia, Italy
A beautiful wine from this lesser known grape variety. Fruity on the nose, with exotic fruit such as melon and banana, featuring hints of citrus reminiscent of grapefruit

7 Sauvignon Blanc, Kuraka			£29.95
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– Marlborough, New Zealand
Passion fruit & gooseberry on the nose with wild limes coming through in this amazing finish

8 Albarino, Alba Vega			£30.95
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– Galicia, Spain
Clean and fresh with delicate citrus notes on the nose and a palate packed with green apple, orange peel and lime flavours.

9 Bacchus, Sharpham Dart Valley Reserve			£34.95
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– Devon, England
Fruit aromas with hints of vanilla, ripe fruit with balanced acidity, a touch of residual sugar and a hint of oak.

10 Sancerre, "Le Perrier"			£42.95
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Domain Jean Thomas – Loire, France
Crisp, steely and fresh with distinct grassy notes of a prime Sancerre. A little more depth and character in the mid-palate, delicious acidity that keeps the wine fresh and interesting.
